IMPORTANT WORDS:

Je suis means *I am*

et means *and*

il est means *he is*

elle est means *she is*

aussi means *also*

très means *very*

toujours means *always*

Examples: a) Je m'appelle Marc. Je suis grand, courageux et beau.

My name is Mark. I am tall, brave and good-looking.

b) Je m'appelle Emma. Je suis petite, gentille, studieuse et honnête.

My name is Emma. I am short, kind, studious and honest.

a) Mon amie Christine est intéressante.

My friend Christine is interesting.

b) Elle est toujours heureuse.

She is always happy.

c) Pierre est égoïste.

Pierre is selfish.

d) Il est très jeune.

He is very young.

e) La dentiste est aimable.

The dentist is friendly.

G. Extension Activity 3 - Dialogue

Read the dialogue below between a boy (un garçon) and a girl (une fille). The French adjectives are underlined. The English is underneath each line of French.

Le garçon : Tu as vu l'accident hier, à la télévision ? Les pompiers sont très courageux!

Boy: Have you seen the accident yesterday on television? Firemen are very brave!

La fille : Mon cousin est pompier. Il est sportif et fort.

Girl: My cousin is a fireman. He is athletic and strong.

Le garçon : Moi je suis trop faible et timide pour être un héros.

Boy: Me, I'm too weak and timid to be a hero.

La fille : Ne dis pas cela ! Tu es intelligent et drôle. Ce sont aussi des qualités de héros.

Girl: Don't say that! You're smart and funny. These are also qualities of a hero.

Le garçon : Mais je ne suis pas naïf : jamais je ne serai Superman.

Boy: But I'm not naive: I will never be Superman.

La fille : Et tu es trop sérieux pour aller sauver le monde...

Girl: And you're too serious to go save the world ...

Le garçon : Je suis studieux, c'est différent !

Boy: I'm studious, it's different!

La fille : Je plaisante !

Girl: Just kidding!
