SCHOOL BANKING UPDATE

The next Token Redemption Day will be Friday, 22 November 2013.

- USB sticks (which were a reward item in 2012) are also available this term. We don't have a redemption coupon for this item so if you want one just write 'USB Stick', your name, class and School Banking student ID number on a piece of paper and submit with your 10 silver tokens.

What do you need to do?

Redemption coupons will be placed in School Banking books in the next few weeks. Please bring in your 10 tokens and a redemption coupon for your chosen reward in with your child's School Banking on Friday, 22 November 2013. We will then order the reward and have it back to your child as soon as we receive it. If your chosen reward item is not available, we will let you know so that you can chose another reward.

What happens if I miss out?

If you don't bank on 22 November don't worry, just submit your 10 tokens and redemption coupon for your reward the next time you bank. Just remember to do it as soon as possible so that you get your reward before the end of term!

PLEASE NOTE – CHANGES TO REWARDS PROGRAM IN 2014

In 2014 the Commonwealth Bank is switching from the current manual reward ordering system to a Web based system. Children will still order rewards the same way by collecting tokens and redeeming 10 of them for a reward, but the new system will make it easier for coordinators to order rewards and track eligibility for rewards.

What rewards can be claimed?

There are some items from previous terms still available for redemption. Reward items currently available are:

- Spen Moneybox
- Cred Moneybox
- Pat the Dog Moneybox
- Addy Moneybox
- Pru Moneybox

Due to the new system children will only be able to carry over a MAXIMUM of 9 tokens from 2013 to 2014. So if you are holding on to lots of tokens you need to redeem these this term! Also if you reach 10 tokens after 22 November, make sure you claim a reward 1-2 weeks before the end of term so we have time to order and receive your reward.

Money boxes will not be available in 2014 so if you want a money box you must order it as a reward this term.
