Literacy



What's happening in 1/2R

What's Happening in 3/4M!

Literacy

Students in 3/4M vary greatly in their literacy needs and ability levels. As a result, it is necessary to provide multiple opportunities for students to read, write, participate in meaningful experiences, and collaborate with others so that they can develop their ability to read and comprehend texts. 3/4M participate in weekly reading groups where the students work

independently and collaboratively with partners or in small groups to meet literacy goals.



Numeracy

This week, 3/4M students learnt how to measure the volume of containers using informal units such as place value cubes. Students worked in groups of three to assemble three different sized cardboard containers. They estimated the volume of each container and then filled each of the containers with place value cubes (1cm cubes) to work out the volume.

The thing I really liked about this activity is that when I was wondering around, some children had different strategies for working out the volume of the box. (For example, only measure length, then height, then width!) It was wonderful to see the children's thinking!






Great Book Swap

UPDATE: the final amount that we raised for the Indigenous Literacy was \$679.80, with over 500 books re-distributed amongst the families of our generous school community.








PRC SuperStars Celebration



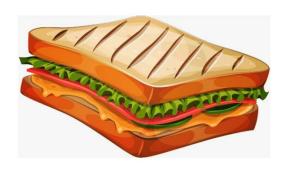
